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Project Details:

In 2004, leading construction company Carillion joined a long term three way partnership with Surrey council and Ringway Highway Services with the aim to delivery quality highway services to Surrey and the surrounding boroughs and districts.



The local authority formed an alliance with Carillion and Ringway to undertake work such as highway inspections, maintenance, emergency call outs, surface dressing, structures and design. Carillion will work on and maintain 5 districts in the East and Ringway in the west.

The contract strategy was devised in order to meet the recommendations of the Best Value Review of Managing and Maintaining the Highway Network, the aim of this strategy is to provide a more innovative approach to highway design and maitenacnce.

The projects is estimated at £40million per annum, (Ringway £18million and Carillion £22million) and began in April 2003. Dependant on the level of service provided by Ringway and Carillion the length of the contract is likely to be extended up to 7 years.
