Project Details:

Construction Company Carillion began work on Scotland's first university of the 21st century in February 2004. Queen Margaret University is Scotland's first new university campus in forty years

The £45million project was laid out over 35 acres of land and was project managed by Heery.

The university was opened to students in August 2007, it included student residences, student union, Lecture theatres, science and lecture laboratories, indoor sports facilities, catering outlets and landscaped gardens.



The university was been designed by Dyer Associates to have minimal impact on the environment. The universities carbon emissions

have been reduced by 75% from implementing a biomass heating system and thin client technology.

The excellent sustainable design has been recognised and awarded BREEAM (Building Research Establishment Environmental Assessment Method) 'Excellent rating' making it the most sustainable university in the UK.
